DAY TRIP TO RICHMOND

Richmond, British Columbia, is a convenient and relaxing stopover for travellers before or after a cruise, RV trip, or a broader BC adventure. Just minutes from Vancouver International Airport (YVR), this dynamic city makes it easy to unwind and explore without straying far.

POST CRUISE

Cruise passengers booking a Vancouver City tour with Landsea Tours & Adventures or Westcoast Sightseeing can request dropoff service at your Richmond hotel or at Vancouver International Airport (YVR). Alternatively, the Canada Line SkyTrain provides direct service from the cruise terminal to Richmond City Centre and the airport.

POST RV

RV travelers will also find it easy—most rental companies offer return service to your Richmond hotel or to the Vancouver International Airport (YVR).

PLAN YOUR DAY

A full day's adventure begins in Steveston Village, a historic seaside village with deep ties to Canada's maritime past. Start your visit at the **Gulf of Georgia Cannery National Historic Site** (1 hour), one of the area's most significant landmarks. Built in 1894, this former salmon cannery now houses a museum that offers a fascinating look at the West Coast's fishing industry and the people who shaped it.

From there, stroll along **Moncton Street** (1 hour), where unique boutiques, local art shops, and welcoming cafés line the village's walkable core. It's the perfect place to enjoy a leisurely stroll while you shop for gifts, clothing, or art pieces. The quaint atmosphere is further enhanced by views of the nearby harbour and working fishing boats.

For a scenic lunch, head to **Blue Canoe**Waterfront Restaurant (1.5–2 hours), where fresh, locally sourced seafood is served with stunning views of the marina. The menu highlights Pacific Northwest flavours in a relaxed yet refined setting. If you're after something more casual, **Pajo's Fish & Chips** is a beloved local spot. Located on a famous floating dock at the Fisherman's Wharf, it's a go-to spot for perfectly crispy fish and golden fries. Enjoy your lunch outdoors by the water (1 hour), surrounded by the laid-back charm of the harbour.

After lunch, continue your waterfront walk to the **Britannia Shipyards National Historic Site** (1 hour). This remarkable cluster of preserved buildings—once home to boatworks, canneries, bunkhouses, and residences—offers a compelling

glimpse into the multicultural working communities that shaped the region's early development in shipbuilding and fishing industry.

If you prefer an indoor activity, make your way to the Richmond Olympic Experience (1–1.5 hours), housed inside the **Richmond Olympic Oval**. This interactive museum brings the spirit of the 2010 Vancouver Winter Olympic and Paralympic Games to life through immersive exhibits, sports simulators, and Olympic memorabilia—ideal for visitors of all ages, especially sports enthusiasts.
