EXPLORE, EAT, SHOP

Ready to shop, snack, and sightsee your way through Richmond? Let this flavour-packed itinerary guide you through the city's top spots—with time to browse, bite, and bring home a few stylish finds.

DAY 1

Start your day with a classic dim sum breakfast at **Fisherman's Terrace Restaurant** (1.5 hours), a local favourite located inside **Aberdeen Centre**—one of Richmond's most iconic Asian malls. After your meal, take time to explore the mall's diverse shops and catch the synchronized fountain display (1 hour).

From adjoining **Aberdeen Station**, board the Canada Line SkyTrain and travel two stops to **Richmond-Brighouse Station**. Directly across the street, **CF Richmond Centre** awaits—a bright, fashion-forward mall with around 200 stores (2 hours). It's also home to a wide selection of food court options—perfect for a bubble waffle or a bubble tea break if you're in need of a recharge.

After a day of shopping, it's time to unwind with dinner.

OPTION 1

Travel by taxi to **Steveston Village**, recently named Metro Vancouver's #1 neighbourhood, and enjoy a relaxed stroll along Fisherman's Wharf before settling in for a refined evening at **Baan Lao** (2.5 hours). Consistently earning accolades—including being named Canada's Best Restaurant 2024—Baan Lao offers an authentic Royal Thai dining experience that celebrates both heritage and innovation, all while using seasonal ingredients sourced from local farms and waters. Reservations are required and highly recommended for this sought-after culinary gem.



OPTION 2

Prefer something bold and classic? Ride the Canada Line to **Bridgeport Station** and head into the **River Rock Casino Resort** for dinner at **Gordon Ramsay Steak** (2 hours)—the first of its kind in Canada—where signature cuts and elevated sides shine in a stylish setting. Reservations are also recommended for this popular dining experience.

OPTION 3

Craving something more local? Make your way to **Alexandra Road**, fondly known as Food Street (2 hours), a bustling stretch that's home to more than 75 restaurants serving everything from Korean barbecue to Chinese hot pot, offering a taste of Richmond's rich cultural mix.

OPTION 4

If your visit falls on a weekend between April and October, end your evening at the **Richmond Night Market** (2 hours), the largest of its kind in North America. Located just steps from **Bridgeport Station**, this vibrant, open-air market features lively entertainment, unique merchandise, and dozens of mouthwatering street food stalls.

DAY 2

Begin your morning with a leisurely brunch at **The Story Café – Eatery & Bar** (1.5 hours), an award-winning spot that blends comfort classics with inventive twists, all served in a cozy, rustic atmosphere. True to its mantra, "there is a story in everything," this café offers a memorable start to your day.

After brunch, hop back on the Canada Line and travel four stops to **Templeton Station**. Just a short walk away, you'll find **McArthurGlen Designer Outlet Vancouver Airport** (2–3 hours), a European-style open-air village where brand-name deals await. Explore stores like Coach, Jimmy Choo, The North Face, and more, wrapping up your visit with a stylish souvenir or two.
