VANCOUVER AIRPORT TO STEVESTON VILLAGE MAP AND DIRECTIONS

DRIVE

Approximately 25 minutes

1. Head west onto Grant McConachie Way
2. Continue straight to stay on Grant McConachie Way
3. Turn right onto Aurora Connector (towards Miller Road)
4. Turn left at the first cross street, onto Miller Road
5. Turn right onto Russ Baker Way south
6. Cross the No 2 Road Bridge and continue onto No 2 Road
7. Turn right onto Westminster Highway
8. Turn left onto No 1 Road
9. Turn right onto Moncton Street
10. Arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre in Steveston Village

TRANSIT

Approximately 1 hour

1. Take the Canada Line towards Waterfront Station
2. Get off at Bridgeport Station
3. Wait at Bridgeport Station Bay 10
4. Take the 407 Gilbert Bus towards Steveston
5. Get off at Chatham Street and Second Avenue
6. The Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre is a 3-minute walk from your drop off location

BIKE

Approximately 55 minutes

The West Dyke Trail is a scenic cycling route. It hugs Richmond's coast and features views of the Strait of Georgia, Gulf Islands and Vancouver Island.

1. Head west on Grant McConachie Way
2. Turn right onto Miller Road
3. Bike along Miller Road then turn right onto Russ Baker Way south
4. Continue cycling along Russ Baker Way south and cross the No 2 Road Bridge
5. At the end of the No 2 Road Bridge, turn right onto River Road
6. Continue down the Middle Arm Trail
7. At the end of the Middle Arm Trail, head south onto the West Dyke Trail
8. Follow the West Dyke Trail and turn left towards Moncton Street to arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre
